COVID-19 SAFETY PLAN – SNAPSHOT
Last Updated: April 8, 2021



MEASURES WE ARE TAKING:

1. SCREENING

- Members self-screen before entering the club
- “Patron Screening Poster” is posted on clubhouse window and entrance/exit gates
- Anyone who is exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19 or has had close contact with a confirmed case cannot enter the club

2. PHYSICAL DISTANCING

- “Keep Physical Distance” signage is posted on entrance/exit gates
- Online booking system limits bookings to 10 people maximum on the courts, with a maximum of two groups of doubles and one pair of singles
- Members enter by main gate opposite clubhouse and exit by small gate opposite Court 2

3. USE OF MASKS AND FACE COVERINGS

- “Masks Required Indoors” signage is posted on clubhouse window
- Members are responsible to bring their own masks

4. PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)

- Hand sanitizer is available at the club in three locations
- “Masks Required Indoors” signage is posted on clubhouse window

5. HAND HYGIENE AND RESPIRATORY ETIQUETTE

- “Cover Your Cough” signage is posted on clubhouse window
- “Protect Yourself” signage is posted on clubhouse window
- Hand hygiene signs are posted on bulletin board

6. CLEANING AND DISINFECTING

- Cleaning materials are provided
- Clubhouse is locked and washrooms are not available to the membership
- Signage is posted in the clubhouse

IF YOU BECOME ILL:

- People who become ill with COVID-19 symptoms while at Central Tennis Club should go home immediately to self-isolate, and should review the City of Toronto website for more information about COVID-19
- If a tennis player tests positive for COVID-19, their local Public Health Unit (TPH for Toronto residents) will follow up with close contacts who may include other tennis players
- Other tennis players who came in close contact with the infected player may also be required to self-isolate
